



## GARMENT WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Pendle kits are manufactured from top quality materials. All fabrics undergo stringent quality tests to ensure durability and washability. They will give many years of service if properly cared for.

**Always follow the washing instructions on the garment care label and wash all printed garments inside out.**

### Football Kits

**First wash – Always wash shirts, shorts and socks separately to remove any surface dye.**

**Avoid leaving kits folded or bundled together for any length of time whilst damp or soiled as this may cause dye transfer or mildew. Remove excess mud by pre soaking in cool water with detergent as soon as possible after use to avoid stains from setting.**

Garments may discolour due to staining by substances such as mud, grass, petroleum jelly etc....

Stains may not be removed entirely by washing alone. Treat stubborn stains directly with an appropriate stain remover before washing. Take care not to use stain remover on transfers applied to the garment as this may affect the quality of the print. Some of the toughest stains may require more than one treatment especially on light coloured garments.

Do not over load the washing machine and always wash light and dark colours separately.

Do not wash above the temperature stated on the garment care label. (Synthetic wash)

Do not use fabric softener as this may cause a film to build up on the fabric that will prevent the detergent from penetrating the fibres to dislodge any dirt. Also, softener used on printed garments can cause the vinyl stick to itself and may affect the colour of the logo, as well as lose its adhesive property causing the transfer to peel off.

If the garment can be tumble dried (see care label) always tumble dry Cool.

Never iron printed motifs.

### Training Wear

#### Rainsuits, Thermals (Showerproof) and Waterproofs

Rainsuits and Waterproofs do not require regular washing which will remove the water/shower proofing. Instead you should wipe them with a damp cloth. If necessary, wash inside out, no hotter than 30°C synthetic wash. Garments may need to be retreated after washing.

Do not use fabric softener as this will affect any waterproof coating.

Do not tumble dry.

Never iron printed motifs.

### Tracksuits & Clubwear

Wash inside out, no hotter than 40°C synthetic wash.

If the garment can be tumble dried (see care label) always tumble dry Cool.

Do not use fabric softener as this will affect any moisture wicking property.

Never iron printed motifs.
